We are carrying out vital remedial works to the A13/A130 Sadlers Farm roundabout.

These works include improvements to the A13 central reserve crossover.

So we can safely make these improvements, a full closure of the A13 eastbound/westbound carriageways is required, over two weekends.

This includes through traffic from B1464 London Road and Pound Lane.

The closures are planned for two weekends in October, with a third and final weekend contingency closure pending any potential delays due to wet weather etc.

Traffic Management Phases

9pm 12th Oct – 12pm 15th Oct:

A13 Westbound full weekend closure from A13/A130 Link Road junction to Pitsea Flyover Required to safely carry out essential works to the A13 central reserve crossover (Westbound). All traffic management will be removed by 12pm on 15th Oct.

9pm 19th Oct – 12pm 22nd Oct:

A13 Eastbound full weekend closure from Pitsea Flyover to A13/A130 Link Road junction Required to safely carry out essential works to the A13 central reserve crossover (Eastbound). All traffic management will be removed by 12pm on 22nd Oct.

9pm 26th Oct – 12pm 29th Oct:

Contingency weekend closure of A13 Westbound or Eastbound carriageway from Pitsea Flyover to A13/A130 Link Road junction

A contingency closure is planned pending any delays due to wet weather, materials delays or any other **unlikely**, but possible delays.

Diversion routes

12th Oct – 15th Oct:

All Westbound traffic will be diverted via A1245 North to A127 Neverden Interchange, Southmayne, Eastmayne to Pitsea Interchange.

We expect this diversion route to be busy during the closure. Please seek an alternative route or plan ahead for your journey.

19th Oct – 22nd Oct:

All Eastbound traffic will leave the A13 at the Pitsea exit slip road, and diverted via Southmayne, Eastmayne, A127 to Fairglen Interchange, followed by A1245 South to A130 Rayleigh Spur roundabout.

We expect this diversion route to be busy during the closure. Please seek an alternative route or plan ahead for your journey.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When is the project due to complete?

A: We are working to a 12-month programme and our works are due to complete at the end of 2018.

Q: Will there be any road closures?

A: We will implement a multi-phase traffic management plan, comprising of a series of lane closures, overnight and weekend works to carry out the works which will inevitably and unfortunately cause some disruption to road users and local communities. Q: What are your working hours?

A: Our general site hours will be from 7am – 6pm Monday to Friday and we shall undertake selective activities at weekends. Traffic management and other specific works, unable to be carried out during the day, will also be programmed at night between 8pm - 5am.



Q: What works are being undertaken?

A: Our works include the upgrading of existing drainage systems on the A13/A130 Link Road, remedial works to the block retaining wall and bridges, the replacement of bearings on two bridges, embankment re-profiling and carriageway strengthening on the A13 near Pitsea.
